TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Homestead Certificate No. 6014

Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Bloomington, Nebraska, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain;" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Evan T. Hardin has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the south west quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-three, in Township four, and the west half of the northeast quarter and the north east quarter of the north west quarter of section four, in Township three north of range twenty-five west of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred and fifty-eight acres, and seventy-two hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Evan T. Hardin the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Evan T. Hardin and to his heirs and assigns forever.
